


On June 2nd 2022, the International Whores Day, TAMPEP continues its campaign for the rights of migrant sex workers in Europe.

BERLIN germany



The Sex Worker Action Group of Berlin and their allies, call to rally in honour of the International Whores Day 2022!

"In June, we take the streets, strong and determined to demand what we are owed. We rally to remind the politicians and society that decriminalisation is the ONLY legal model that supports and protects sex workers. We rally for those we have lost and for a better future for those who come after us."

According to SWAGB, in Germany the ProstSchG has failed and must be abolished immediately. The current registration procedure censors and removes the autonomy of those who are registered. It pushes the more marginalized sex workers further into illegality and harm. The current law is violent!

DEMANDS

- Social and institutional destigmatization and recognition of sex work as a profession through information, outreach and networking.
- Full decriminalization and abolition of repressive special regulations against sex workers. Abolition of "\$184f (StGB), Exercise of prohibited prostitution" to abolish restricted areas. Abolition of the mandatory registration as sex worker and destructive regulations towards workplaces, as included in the "ProstituiertenSchutzGesetz".
- Legal rights for sex workers, written by sex workers. Improvement of our working and living conditions.

HAMBURG germany



On June $2^{\rm nd}$, Ragazza, organisation that provides support for women who use drugs and are engage in sex work, sets up a stand on the Hansaplatz, in Hamburg's St. Georg district, to take the opportunity to highlight the negative consequences of the Prostitutes Protection Act, the Restricted Area Ordinance and the No Contact Ordinance.

Other Hamburg organisations and allies support ragazza's initiative while painting red umbrellas on the square with chalk, putting up red balloons and red umbrellas, to call attention to sex workers' working and living conditions while talking to the public and the press.

INNSBRUCK austria



Sex work: between paragraphs and condemnations

Reading from the book I am a sex worker, followed by a discussion on current problems in Innsbruck. The book, published by the campaign Sex Work is Work, gives sex workers a voice that is often too little heard in the media and by politicians.

SKOPJE north macedonia



STAR, The First Sex Workers Collective in the Balkans, in partnership with HOPS, Healthy options project Skopje and TransFormA, an Initiative for the Protection and Promotion of Transgender People's Rights in North Macedonia is launching on June 2nd 2022 a video called Why Skopje deserves the Red Light Districts back.

The video's goal is to show the benefits and positive aspects of sex work for sex workers, through the history of old Skopje, where public brothels and places existed where the "ladies of the night" worked and offered sexual services to their clients. Numerous records, artworks and testimonies reflect sex work in Old Skopje.

The campaign aims to reduce the negative social perception of sex work and raise awareness among the general population regarding the recognition of sex work as work.

Within the campaign, a podcast will be the launch, hosted by a sex worker and three sex workers as guests, who will be talking about the positive aspects of their work in sex work.


On June 2nd, a social gathering event will be organised for our community in the daily centre of HOPS. The video and the podcast will be promoted through our social media.

STAR has identified core problems faced by the community and is focusing on three priorities:

- Improve the legal frame concerning voluntary sex work through advocacy and community inclusion in the promotion of the human rights of all sex workers
- Increase the access to social and legal protection, improve the access to sexual and reproductive health for sex workers, and provide services not offered by the state
- Improve the development and the capacities on community level, by securing financial stability, organisational development, empowerment, engagement and participation of the community.

VIENNA austria



On the International Sex Workers Day 2022, LEFÖ, Counselling, Education and Accompaniment for Migrant Women, once again call for the decriminalization of sex workers and to end the hypocrisy and double standards how sex work is treated.

For the 2nd of June, LEFÖ is organizing - in cooperation with various partners and organizations - a public event in a central and heavily circulated square of Vienna: the Urban-Loritz-Platz, Burggasse station, in front of the City Library, in the 7th district.

Just like in the previous years, the public event will be accompanied by music, live acts, speeches, an info desk, flash mob, etc.

The event will be focusing on the difficult situation in which sex workers still find themselves due to the covid 19 crises: having their jobs greatly reduced, which led to financial shortages, increasing poverty, financial insecurity and isolation.

We will be demanding respect and rights, as well as a violence free, safe and a welcoming society for sex workers.

ZURICH switzerland



ProCoRe, *Prostitution Collective Reflection*, is the national network advocating the interests of sex workers in Switzerland.
