SEX WORKERS. A QUITE NORMAL LIFE

The organisation SXA is currently showing a photo exhibit by Tim Oehler - SEX WORKERS. DAS GANZ NORMALE LEBEN (Sex Workers. A quite normal life) - at their premises Infocafé Palaver, Lendplatz 38, in Graz.


The exhibition will end on June 2th, the International Sex Workers' Day, with speeches, a few welcoming words via video from the artist, a little buffet and time for questions and discussions related to sex work.


Along the lines of "Don't judge a life you haven't lived yourself", sex workers give

insights into their everyday lives. In very personal texts, they describe their view of sex work. Their portraits, their voices and their thoughts depict facets of a diverse and stigmatised life that is not just black and white.

The goal is to give sex workers a voice, through pictures and texts.







AUSTRIA | Vienna

MORE RIGHTS FOR SEX WORKERS!

For the 2023 International Sex Worker's Day, Vienna is organizing a public event at the Urban-Loritz-Platz, 1070 Vienna. It will be hosted by several organisations: Lefö, Grüne Frauen Wien, Amnesty International/Netzwerk Frauenrechte, sexworker.at, Red Edition and the Queer Sex Workers Collective. There will be music, speeches, info-points, a flash mob, and much more!

The **demands** are:

- No paternalism and political instrumentalization of sex workers!
- Stop criminalization of sex workers!
- Stop criminalization of clients!
- Stop the double standards with regard to sex work!
- The legal recognition of sex work as work!
- Residence and work rights for migrant women in the sex work.
- Involvement of sex workers in all laws that affect them.
- Sufficient good and safe work places for sex workers.
- Protection from violence, discrimination, sexism and racism.

GERMANY | Hamburg

50 YEARS SUPPORTING SEX WORKERS ON THE REEPERBAHN

For 50 years, the Sperrgebiet on St. Pauli (formerly Kaffeeklappe) has been a meeting place for sex workers, where they get support and counselling.

On June 2nd, the International Sex Workers' Day, the organisation will review these five decades experience, taking a look at the current situation and the challenges of social work in the milieu.

The event will take place in the premises of the Sperrgebiet St. Pauli at Seilerstraße 34, 20359 Hamburg, with talks about the discrimination and stigma sex workers face, and a tour through St. Pauli.





GREECE | Athens, Thessaloniki AWARENESS RAISING FOR SEX WORKERS' RIGHTS

The organisation RED UMBRELLA, with branches in Athens and Thessaloniki, will organise the following on June 2nd:

- a press release which shall be signed by several Greek organizations, to maximize its impact
- social media posts and an online campaign to raise awareness for sex workers' rights
- an interview on TV

Sex Workers Speak out: FOR RIGHTS, AGAINST CRIMINALISATION

Italian sex workers' movements and organisations will meet on June 2nd at a Congress. They are organising a public meeting on "Sex Workers Speak Out, for Rights, against Criminalization", held in Bologna on June 3rd 2023, from 9.30am to 4.00pm at the Auditorium Enzo Biagi di Sala Borsa.

20 years after their last collective and public event, sex workers' organizations in Italy will publicly take the floor again to discuss the issue of sex work.

The meeting is open to interested citizens, experts, policy makers and the press. It will feature sex workers' organizations in their struggle for rights and the decriminalization of sex work.

A press conference will be held between 10.00 and 11.00am. A city parade with the sex workers and allies will close the event of the Congress.

LIVING LIBRARY WITH SEX WORKERS

On June 2nd, the International Sex Workers' Day, **STAR**, **The First Sex Workers Collective in the Balkans** is starting the **SEX WORKERS' MONTH** campaign, within the frames of which we organize public events in three cities in North Macedonia:

The purpose behind the "Living Library with Sex Workers" events is to sensitize the broader public regarding sex workers rights, organized according to the "living library" concept, which enables interaction among people as a tool to overcome the prejudices and stereotypes in a safe public space. At the events, visitors from the general population will have the opportunity to hear out sex workers' personal stories and ask questions about their experiences.






SWITZERLAND | LUCERN
